



IN CONSIDERATION of the minor's participation in any activities with The World Baseball Academy (the "Academy"), and on behalf of the minor, I represent that:

1.) This application form is complete and accurate, and the minor has permission to engage in all activities unless otherwise specified in writing. 2.) The minor has been medically cleared, is in good health, and is in proper physical condition to participate in the activities, and, if I believe the conditions are unsafe, I agree to discontinue the minor's participation immediately. 3.) I fully understand the nature and risks of the activities, including injuries, disabilities, illnesses, death, damages, or losses (the "Incidents") which the minor may sustain as a result of his/her participation in athletics, the use of any equipment, exercises, or other activities. 4.) I expressly acknowledge that I assume the risk of Incidents which may result from his/her participation in these activities. 5.) I will release and hold harmless the Academy, its staff, Eric Wedge, and its volunteers (the "Releasees") for all liability, claims, demands, or Incidents arising out of his/her participation in the activities, including those which arise out of the action, inaction, or negligence of the Academy or Releasees. 6.) In the event of an Incident, I authorize the Academy and Releasees to act as guardians in granting permission for emergency treatment or hospitalization (including anesthesia) if believed necessary for the minor. I understand that should an Incident arise, someone from the Academy or Releasees will attempt to contact me, but if I cannot be reached by phone, such medical treatment as deemed necessary by competent medical personnel is authorized. 7.) If, despite this waiver and release, suit is filed by anyone on behalf of my child, I will indemnify the Academy and Releasees from any litigation expenses, costs, attorney fees, liability, claims, demands, or Incidents as a result of such claim. 8.) I consent to and authorize the creation, use, reproduction, dissemination, and publication by the Academy of the minor's name and likeness, including any photographs and video, for which the Academy retains exclusive rights, for any purpose, without compensation to me, the child, or assignees. 9.) The minor is a child in my custody, and that I am his/her parent or guardian.
